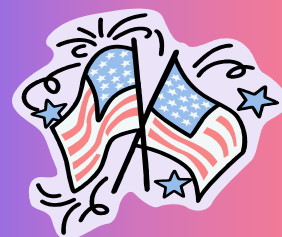

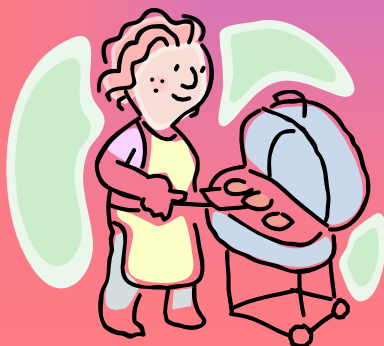

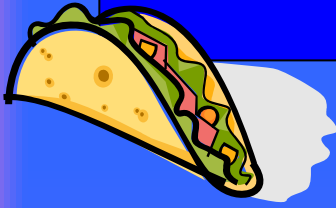

September 15th to October 15th is National Hispanic Heritage Month



Hispanic Heritage Month begins on September 15, the anniversary of independence for five Latin American countries—Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. In addition, Mexico declared its independence on September 16, and Chile on September 18.

The term Hispanic, as defined by the U.S. Census Bureau, refers to Spanish-speaking people in the United States of any race. On the 2000 Census form, people of Spanish/Hispanic/Latino origin could identify themselves as Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, or "other Spanish/Hispanic/Latino." More than 35 million people identified themselves as Hispanic or Latino on the 2000 Census.

We will be hosting several fun activities that bring awareness to Spanish culture. The Pre-K classes will be having a potluck taste testing on September 30th at 11 o'clock. We will be asking parents to bring in their favorite Spanish/Latin dishes for the children to try. We will also be having a school wide translating contest. We will have several short stories for our families to take home and translate from Spanish to English. The first family to bring it back, correctly translated into English, will receive a small prize. (No cheating 😊) Also if you have any items from your own culture that you would like to bring in and share with our students please do.
